APPENDIX TO THE APPLICATION FORM

1. The present document is attached to the application form filed for the registration of the domain name :

This appendix forms an integral part of the registration contract which the entity seeking registration subscribes with DNS-LU.

2. This registration contract, which is to be concluded by the applicant with the DNS-LU, is governed by the provisions of the Terms and Conditions, the Domain Name Charter and the documents Trade form and Fees for domain name registration, all issued by the registrar DNS-LU. The applicant formally declares having carefully read and understood all these documents. The applicant fully approves among others the payment of the corresponding fee of 40 EURO, incl 17% VAT upon reception of the registration confirmation, respectively 40 EURO incl 17% VAT (14,04 EURO for eligible institutions connected to the RESTENA network) as annual subscription fee in the years to follow.

3. In accordance with article 9 of its Terms and Conditions, DNS-LU is entitled to delete an active or inactive registration of a second level domain name from the repository, notably in the following cases:

- (a) When no or insufficient payment for registration/reservation is received.
- (b) When the registration had been unlawful.
- (c) The applicant has provided false information to DNS-LU, or has failed to notify an updated version of its data to DNS-LU within 30 days time.
- (d) The holder of the domain name has ceased to exist.
- (e) The holder fails to respect any of its obligations resulting from its registration contract as outlined here above.

4. DNS-LU does not accept any responsibility for the use of any domain name on the register of .lu domain names and in particular for any conflict with trade marks, registered or unregistered, or with rights to names in other contexts. DNS-LU is hereby expressly exempted from any and all responsibility for the verification of rights to an Application form for a second level domain name under the .lu top level domain name. The applicant indemnifies the registry against any claim that the registration of the domain name or the manner in which the domain name is directly or indirectly used infringes the legal rights of any third party and indemnifies the DNS-LU against any reasonable costs and expenses, however they may arise, incurred in defending or dealing with such a claim.

5. In no circumstances will DNS-LU be liable for any loss of use, profit or interruption of business, or any indirect, special, incidental, or consequential damages of any kind regardless of the form of action whether in contract, tort (including negligence), or otherwise, to the registrant, even if the registry has been advised of the possibility of such damages. DNS-LU's liability to the applicant is limited to 125% of the registration fees paid in respect of a particular period of registration.

6. Applicants/holders provide data to DNS-LU to be collected in the WHOIS database within the framework of .lu domain name registration and management request. Limited entries from the database may be searched under certain conditions by any Web user using the WHOIS search service in compliance with its Conditions of Use, available on dns.lu site. The WHOIS database contains personal data processed by DNS-LU as data controller for purposes set forth in the document Domain Name Privacy Notice, available on dns.lu site. Applicants/holders are informed that personal data processing is subjected to the respect of Luxembourg data protection law legislation and the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) (EU) 2016/679 and if the holder registered the domain name solely as a private person, personal data of the holder are per default not published. Data of domain name contacts are not accessible.

7. DNS-LU is entitled to set the domain name inactive (on-hold status), in case, subsequently to the registration of the name, the applicant's nameservers do not respond properly to DNS queries .

8. The domain name policy shall be governed by and construed according to Luxembourg Law. The courts of Luxembourg shall have exclusive jurisdiction in connection with this domain name policy.

9. The registration contract between the entity and the DNS-LU will become effective when the registrant has received a written confirmation by the DNS-LU that the request has been registered. The entity seeking registration of the aforesaid domain name expressly accepts articles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8 of the present appendix.
